## Awana Kick-off Night

We invite you to our kick-off night on Wednesday, September 4. Parents are invited to their children's classrooms from 6:40-7pm for a parent orientation. Awana leaders will meet with you, introduce themselves and talk about the Awana year. At 7pm you are invited to the Welcome Center area for refreshments and fellowship while your children continue Awana orientation until 7:30pm. Understanding that some of you have multiple children in multiple classes we invite you to visit each room and our leaders will have information on a handout for you to take home. Pre-registration is available online. You may also register anytime at Awana drop off, but we encourage pre-registration so we may prepare classes and leaders. You can choose to pay club fees online or at the registration table during the first few weeks of Awana. Please plan to check-in and take children to their classrooms before attending a parent orientation.

## Weekly Club Nights

Weekly Club Time is on **Wednesday evenings from 6:30-7:30 pm** and is comprised of 3 main components 1) Game Time 2) Handbook Time and 3) Classroom Lesson Time. Each week we collect money for our missions offering. We ask for each clubber to bring \$1 per week if they are able. This offering supports our local food pantry, Tri-Area Ministry of Wake Forest. Children also participate in special Theme Nights once per month. Theme Nights give Clubbers an opportunity to dress up according to the theme of the night, as well as add a measure of fun and excitement to the Club Night. Another element to our Awana clubs are Awana Points. Children receive points for wearing their vest or Awana shirt, attendance, memorizing verses, bringing friends and participating in the Theme Nights each month. Twice a year they will attend our Awana store and pick out some items based on the number of points they receive during the year. This is a fun incentive for the children.

## Registration and Check in/out

As much as we would love to offer this at no cost to our clubbers, there are costs that we as a church incur on a yearly basis, and we ask for your help in offsetting a portion of these costs by paying a \$30, once a club-year registration fee (\$45 Family Maximum). We do not want our registration fee to be a hindrance to anyone who wishes to participate in Awana. Scholarships can be offered to assist with the registration fee for those who need it. Please speak with one of our Registration Assistants or Coordinators (Carin Daniels and Chelsey Walker) to receive a Scholarship Application. You can pay by cash, check or online with a credit card at our website.

Each night when you arrive we ask that you check in at our registration table by signing your name beside your children's name(s). We also ask that you check them out each night in the same way and receive a pick-up ticket before going to your clubber's classroom. \*If someone besides the names listed as approved people to check out your clubbers need to pick up your children on a particular night, please contact Carin Daniels.

## Wednesday Night Opportunities

We offer a meal on Wednesday night that starts at 5:30 pm and the cost is \$6 per plate with a family maximum of \$18. Reservations must be made by contacting the church office at (919) 556-5455 prior to 2:00 pm each Monday. If for some reason you are unable to participate in our meal due to financial reasons, please notify the church office for assistance.

We not only offer opportunities for Children on Wednesday nights, but also opportunities for youth (6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade) as well as parents. Our Youth participate in a Small Group Bible Study, 6:30-7:30 pm. Each Wednesday night from 6:30-7:30 pm, our pastors Tito Madrazo and Chris Walker lead an interactive and engaging adult Bible study in our church sanctuary. We also offer a Moms on Wednesday (MOW) small group in our nursery for ladies of all ages. Children under the age of 2 are invited in this room during Awana. We have a paid nursery worker/facilitator of the small group that meets while young children play.
